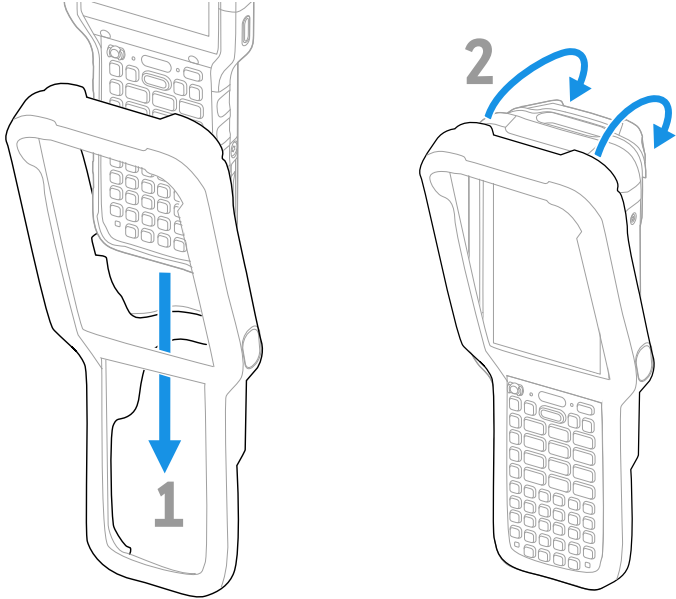

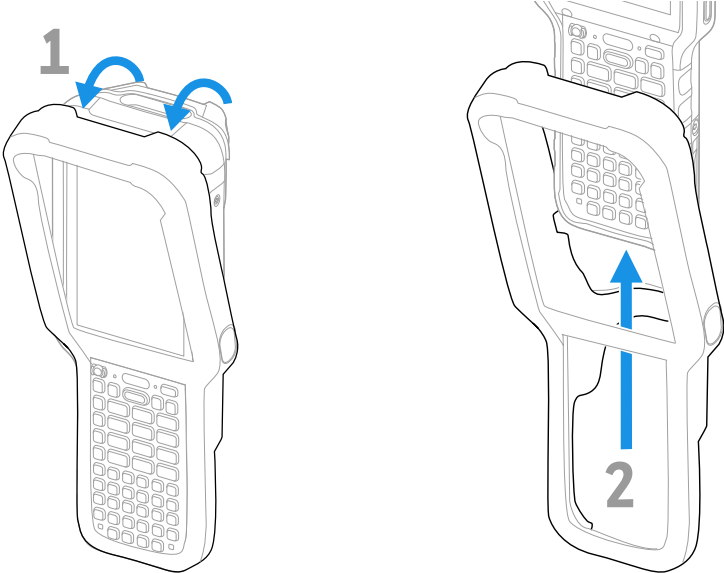

Routinely inspect the protective boot for damage and replace if needed.



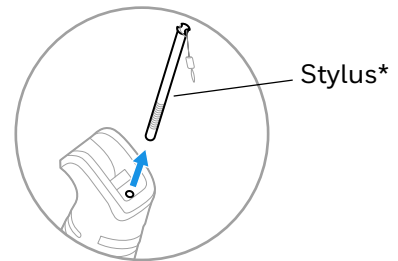
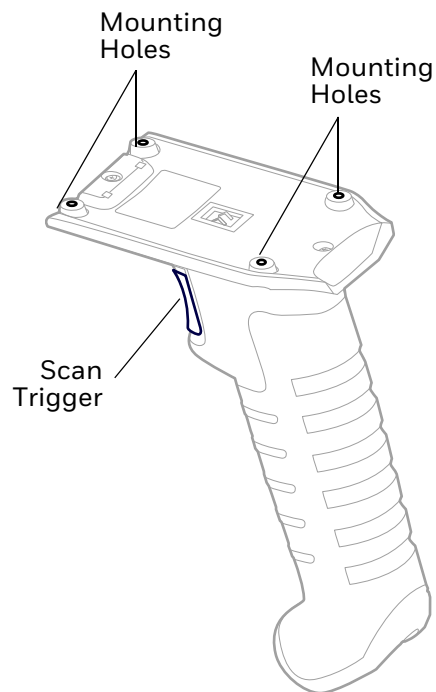
SCAN HANDLE

A scan handle attaches to the mobile computer to provide a handle grip and pull-trigger for barcode scanning. Honeywell offers the following scan handle for the CK67 Series:

- CK67-SCH for use with a CK67 with or without a boot attached.

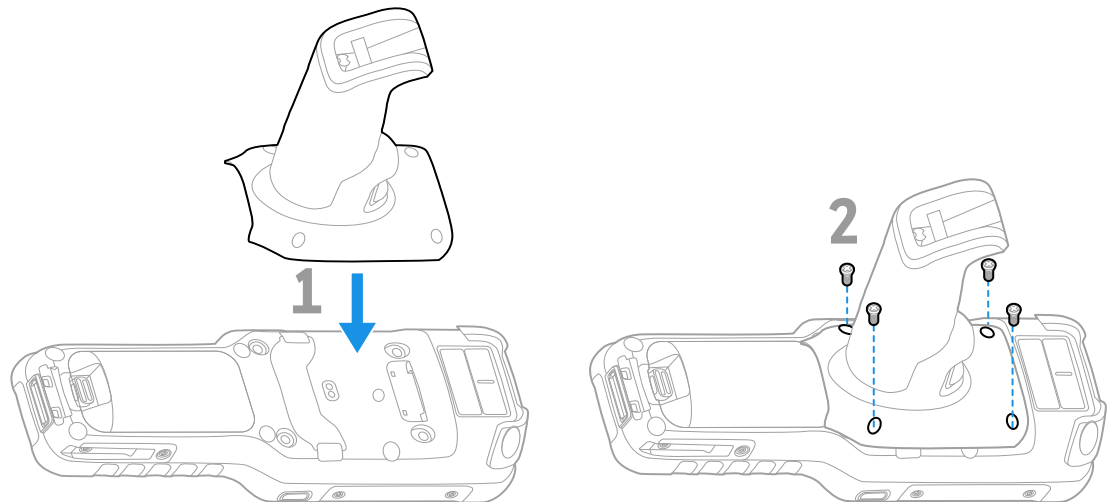
Make sure that your shipping box contains the following:

- Scan Handle (CK67-SCH)
- M2.5 x 7 Screws (4)

Attach Scan Handle

The CK67-SCH is compatible with a CK67 with or without a protective boot attached.



Scan a Bar Code

Press the trigger on the handle to scan a bar code.



UNIVERSAL DOCK HOME BASE AND ETHERNET HOME BASE

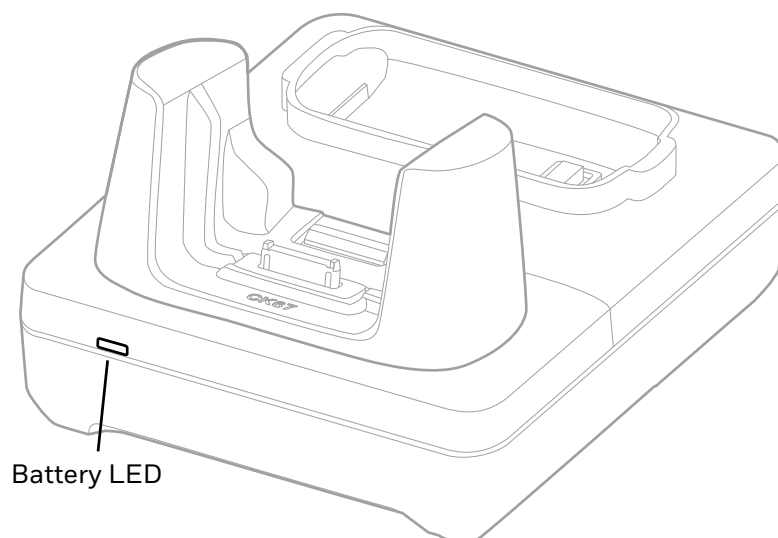
A Home Base is a charge/communication base for one mobile computer and one spare battery. The Home Base has one USB client connector.

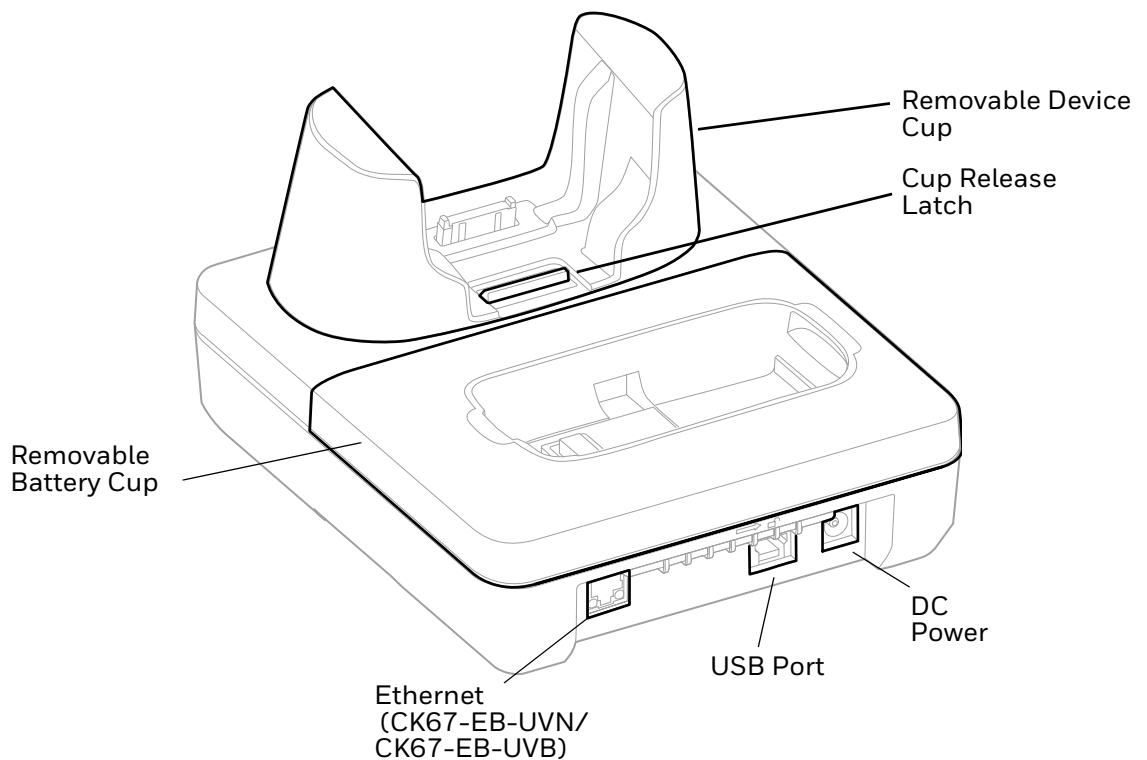
An Ethernet Home Base is also a charge/communication base for one mobile computer and one spare battery. However, the Ethernet Base also has an Ethernet connector as well as a USB client connector (Type B).

Note: *Ethernet communication is not supported when a USB cable is connected to the Ethernet base and a host device (e.g., laptop or desktop computer).*

The CK67-HB-UVB Universal Home Base and CK67-EB-UVB Universal Ethernet Base are boot-compatible. The CK67-HB-UVN Universal Home Base and CK67-EB-UVN Universal Ethernet Base must be used with a computer without a boot attached. Universal bases have removable cups that can be replaced. (See [Universal Dock Cups](#) on page 21.) These bases also have removable battery cups (see page 14).

Out of the Box

Make sure that your shipping box contains these items:

- Home Base (CK67-HB-UVN/CK67-NB-UVB) or Ethernet Home Base (CK67-EB-UVN/CK67-EB-UVB)
- Power supply
- Power cord (if purchased)
- Product documentation

If any items are missing or appear damaged, contact your Customer Account Representative. Keep the original packaging in the event that you need to return an item or if you want to store it while not in use.

Connect Power

Use only a UL Listed power supply that has been qualified by Honeywell with an output rated at 12VDC and 3A. The power supply input rating is 90-264 VAC, 50/60 Hz. The operating temperature is -10 °C to 50 °C (14 °F to 122 °F). The maximum output of the base is 5VDC/2A.

1. Plug the power cord into the power supply.
2. Plug the power supply cable into the power connector on the back of the base.

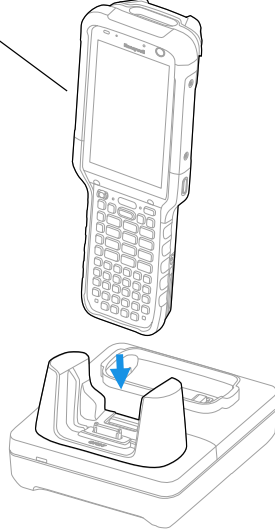
3. Plug the power cord into a standard wall outlet.

Charge the Battery Pack

Insert the computer into the Home Base (CK67-HB-UVN, CK67-HB-UVB) or Ethernet Home Base (CK67-EB-UVN, CK67-EB-UVB). The unit will not charge unless a battery is installed.

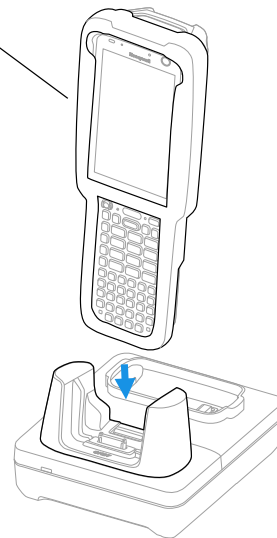
CK67-HB-UVN/CK67-EB-UVN

without protective boot

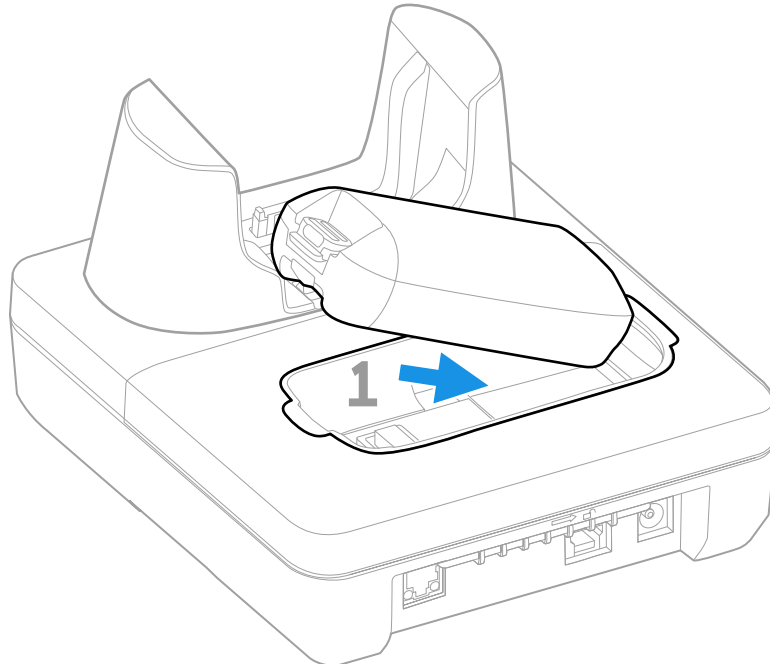


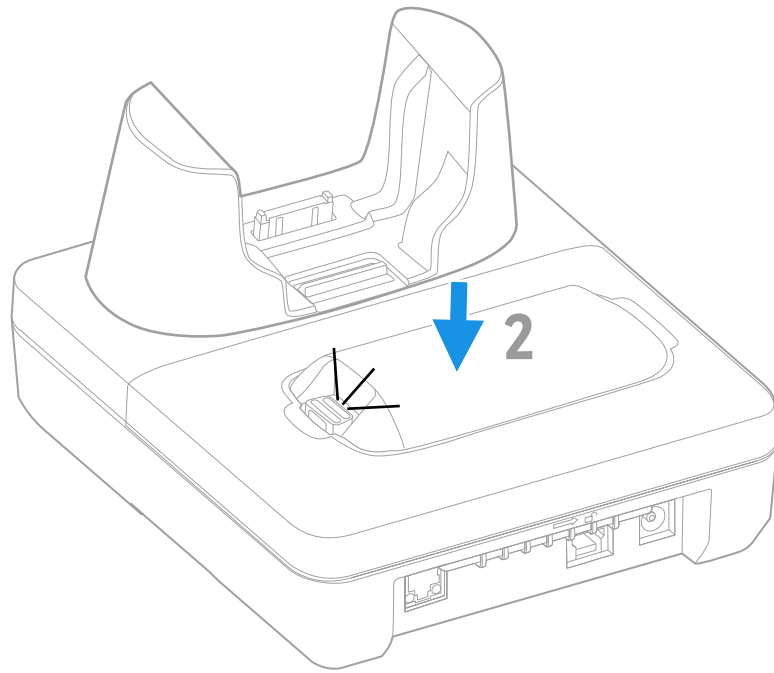
CK67-HB-UVB/CK67-EB-UVB

You can also insert a battery pack into the Home Base for charging.





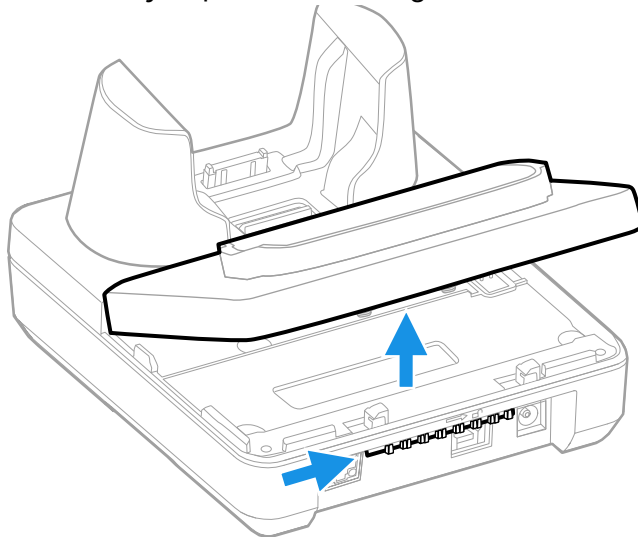
Replace the Battery Cup

The CK67 home base and Ethernet home base have a replaceable battery cup (CK67-UCP-BATTHEB).

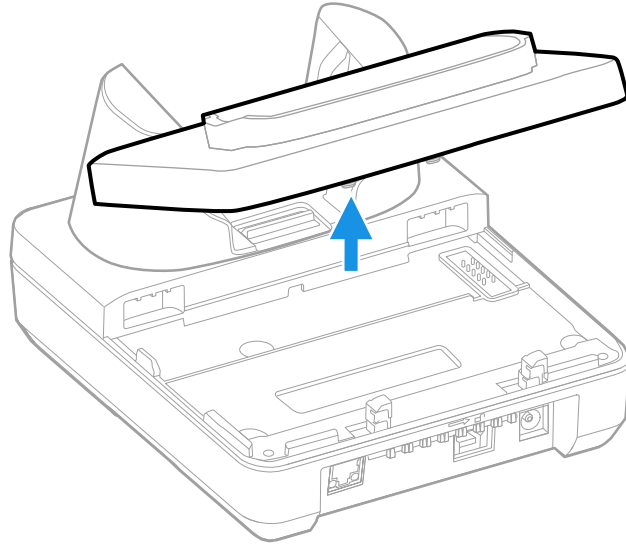


Caution: Keep the base flat to avoid dropping the battery cup.

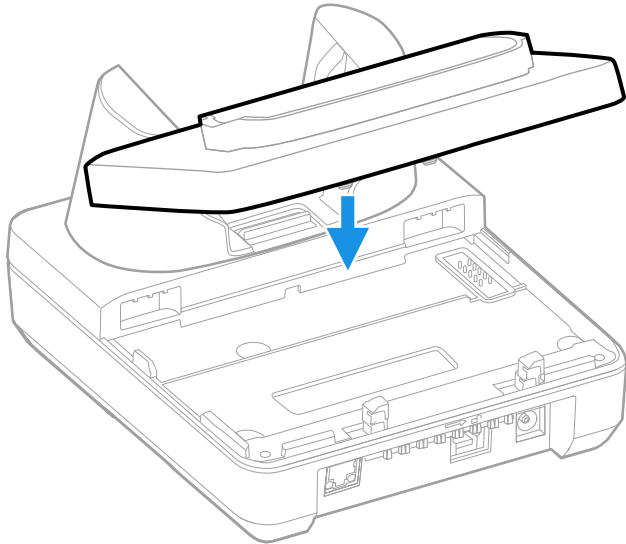
1. Remove all cables to allow clear access to the latch.
2. While holding the battery cup latch to the right, lift the back of the cup.



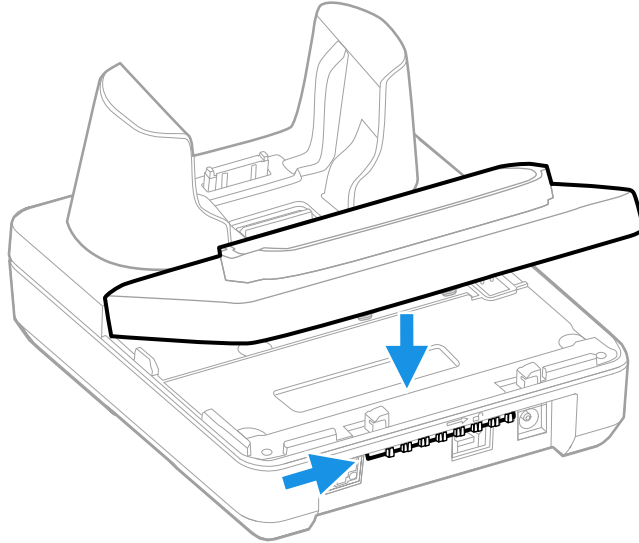
3. Release the latch and lift the old cup out of the base.



4. Insert the new cup tilted slightly towards the front of the base.



5. While holding the latch to the right, push the back of the cup into the base until it snaps in.



6. Release the latch.

Status LED

LED	Status	Description
Battery	Solid Green	The battery is connected to external power and is fully charged.
	Solid Amber	The battery is connected to external power and is charging.
	Solid Red	There is a battery charging fault, such as over-temperature.

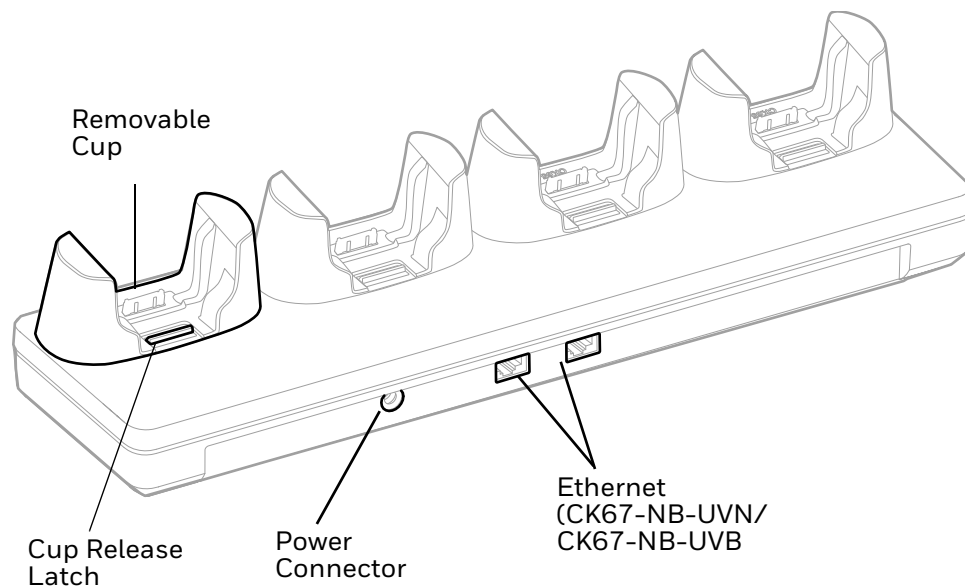
UNIVERSAL CHARGE BASE AND NET BASE

Universal Dock Charge Bases CK67-CB-UVN and CK67-CB-UVB charge up to four mobile computers. Model CK67-CB-UVB is boot compatible.

Ethernet (Net) Bases CK67-NB-UVN and CK67-NB-UVB hold four mobile computers and function as both charge and communication bases, with two RJ45 Ethernet ports. Model CK67-NB-UVB is boot compatible.

Universal bases CK67-CB-UVN, CK67-CB-UVB, CK67-NB-UVN and CK67-NB-UVB have removal cups that can be replaced. (See [Universal Dock Cups](#) on page 21.)

Connect Power

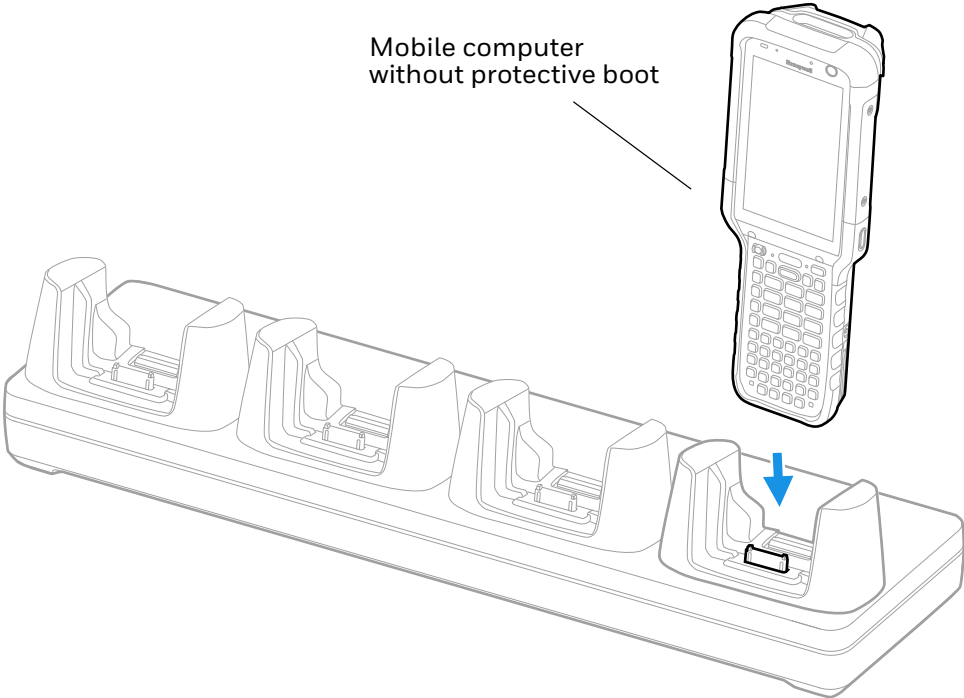
Use only a UL Listed power supply which has been qualified by Honeywell with an output rated at 12V/7A. The power supply input rating is 100-240 VAC, 50/60 Hz. The operating temperature is -10 °C to 50 °C (14 °F to 122 °F).

1. Plug the power cord into the power supply.
2. Plug the power supply cable into the power connector on the back of the charger.
3. Plug the power cord into a standard wall outlet.

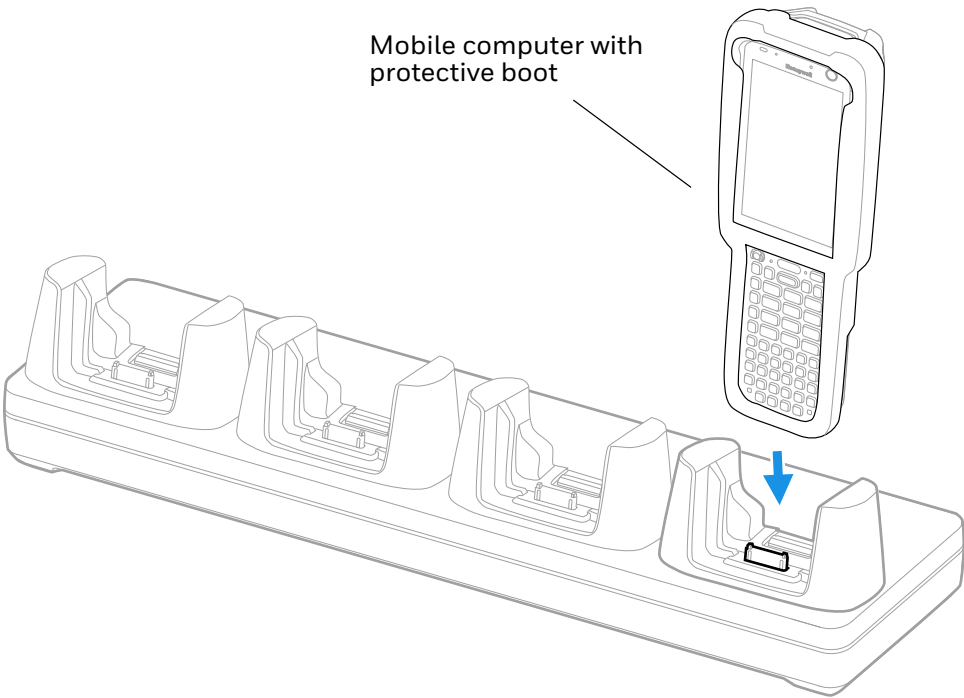
Charge the Battery Pack

- Insert one to four CK65s with battery pack inserted into the Charge Base or Net Base.

UNIVERSAL DOCK CUPS

Universal Bases have removable cups that can be replaced with Universal Cups CK67-UCP-N and CK67-UCP-B.

CK67-UCP-N is for use with a CK67 computer without a boot. CK67-UCP-B must be used with a CK67 computer with a boot attached.

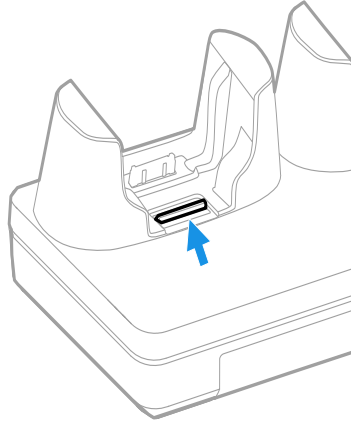

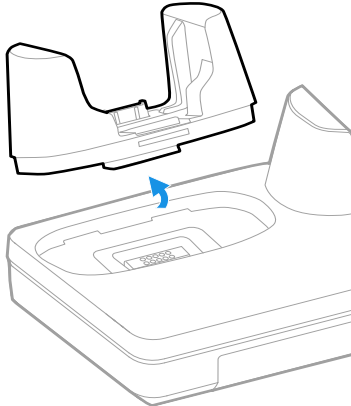
Replacing a Universal Cup

Note: The Universal Charge Base is shown in the instructions below for illustration purposes. The steps for removing and inserting a cup are the same for all universal bases.

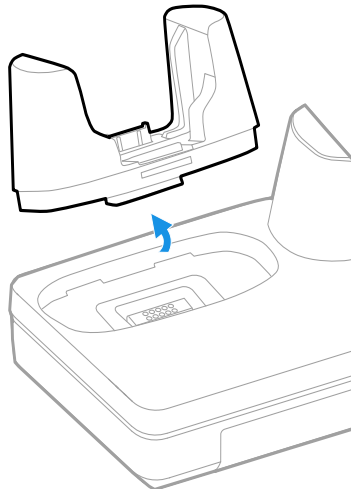
1. Push the latch towards the front of the base.



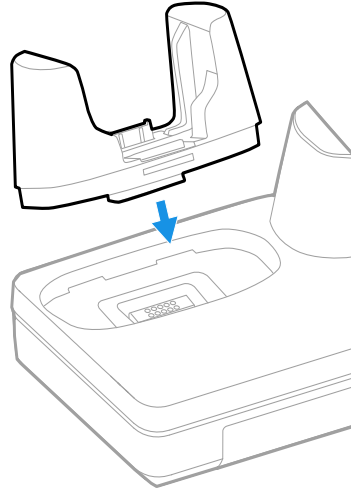
2. Tilt the back of the cup upwards.



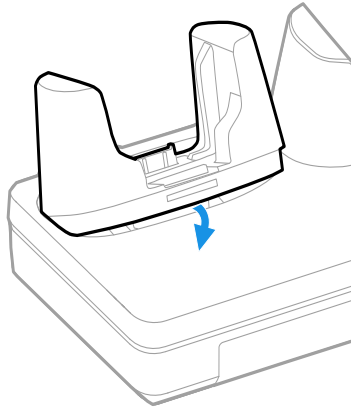
3. Lift the old cup out of the base.



4. Insert the new cup tilted slightly towards the front of the base.



5. Push the cup into the base until it snaps in.



MOUNT A CHARGING DOCK

Mount a Charging Dock

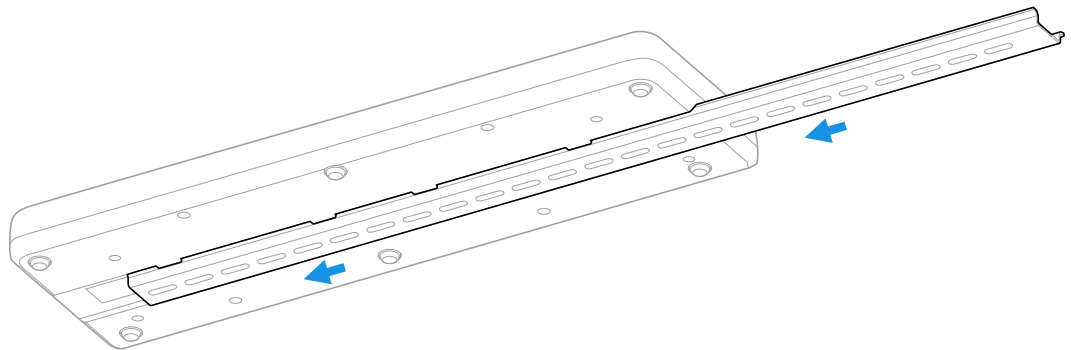
You can mount CK67 Series charge docks on a flat, horizontal surface such as a desktop or workbench with an optional DIN rail.

Mounting hardware required:

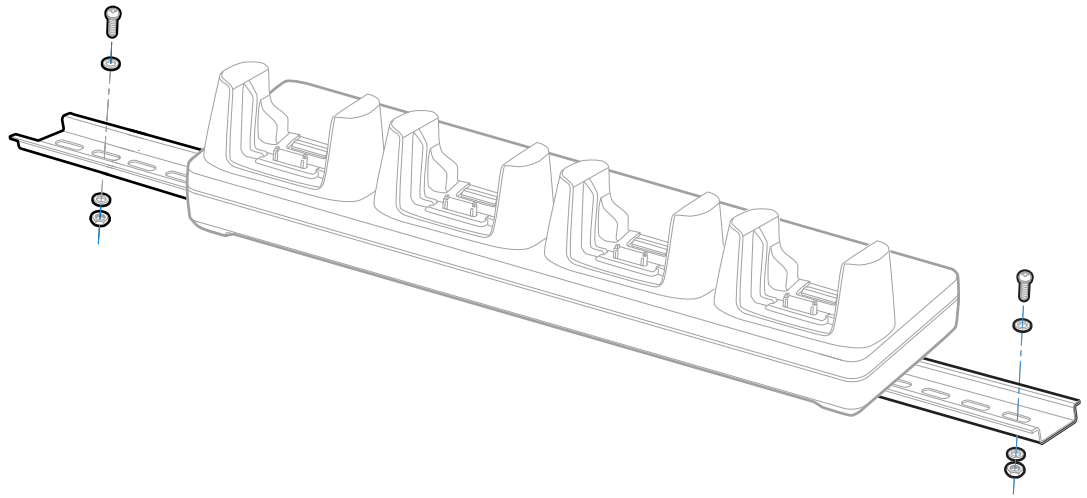
- DIN rail
- 3/16-inch diameter x 5/8-inch long pan head screw
- 1/2-inch OD x 7/32-inch ID x 3/64-inch thick washer
- 3/16-inch diameter nut

Note: A Charge Base is shown in the instructions below for illustration purposes. The mounting steps are the same for all CK67 Series docks and chargers.

1. Slide the DIN rail into the slot on the bottom.



2. Secure the DIN rail to the flat surface with the hardware.
